Assignment Description: Choose any reading on the syllabus – you may choose to read ahead if you like, and pick a reading that we have not yet discussed – and provide a thorough summary, discussing its primary purpose, supporting arguments, and key concepts. In addition to providing a summary of the reading, you must address the question, *how does the reading material imagine the relationship between humans and the natural environment?* In other words, what does the material suggest or argue about the ways in which humans and natural environments connect, interact and combine with one another? How does it suggest these interactions and connections have changed over time? While addressing this broad question, draw on illustrative (relevant) examples from the reading. Place a properly formatted (MLA or APA) citation of the reading at the beginning of your short essay and include a title page with your full name and student number.
