

Instructions

The Laboratory Safety Training is mandatory for students taking chemistry laboratory courses. **Students must pass this training before being allowed into the first lab session.**

The purpose of this training is to inform students of the potential hazards existing in chemistry labs and to teach them safe working procedures.

This training has two parts: Chemistry Lab Safety & WHMIS. Each part consists of a training module and a quiz. Take the training module first, followed by the quiz.

You must pass both parts to complete the training, and you must complete the training before your first lab. **The passing grade of quizzes (Chemistry Lab Safety Quiz & WHMIS Quiz) is 80%!**

Check your grade after each trial of the quiz. Once you get higher than 80%, press the "PrintScreen" button on the keyboard, paste the copied window into a word document, print and show it to your TA in the lab. Note: The print-out needs to show your name and the grade of the quiz. There is an example shown on the next page.
