

ECOR 1606 C-- Mini-User Guide

Getting Started

- select “New” or “Open” from the File menu and follow the instructions

Adding Lines to Your C-- Program:

- right click on the grey "//Program Comments" to add the first comment of the program
- right click on the grey "//Constants" to add the first constant
- right click on the grey "//Variables" to add the first variable
- right click on the grey "//Statements" to add the first statement
- constants and variables can also be added automatically by using them in the "Statements" part of the program
- once you have at least one comment, constant, variable, or statement, right click above or below an existing line to add more lines in that section of the code

Deleting or Moving an Existing Line of a C—Program:

- to delete/cut/move/copy a line of the program, left click on any green part of that line and select the appropriate action

Changing an Existing Line of a C-- Program:

- left click on the white part of any line in the program to edit that part of it
- to add/remove an initial value or a comment from a constant/variable definition, left click on any green part of that line and select the appropriate action
- to delete/cut/move/copy one part of an input/output statement, hold down shift and left click on the “<<” before the item and select the appropriate action
- to insert a new part of an input/output statement, hold down shift and right click on the “<<” where you want to insert
- to add an “else if” or “else” to an if statement with no else, shift / right click on the “end if”
- to add/remove an “else if” or “else” to an if statement shift / left click on an existing “else if” or “else” and choose the appropriate action

Adding a Breakpoint to a C—Program

- left click to change the “traffic light” to the left of any statement from green to red
