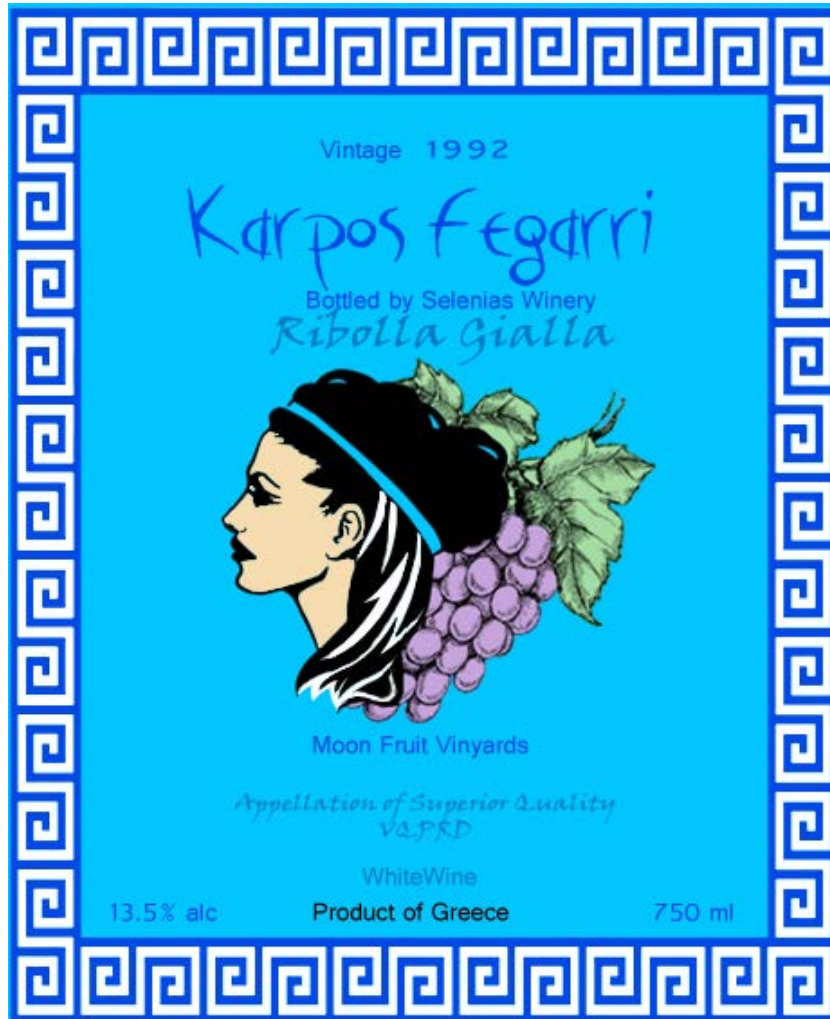
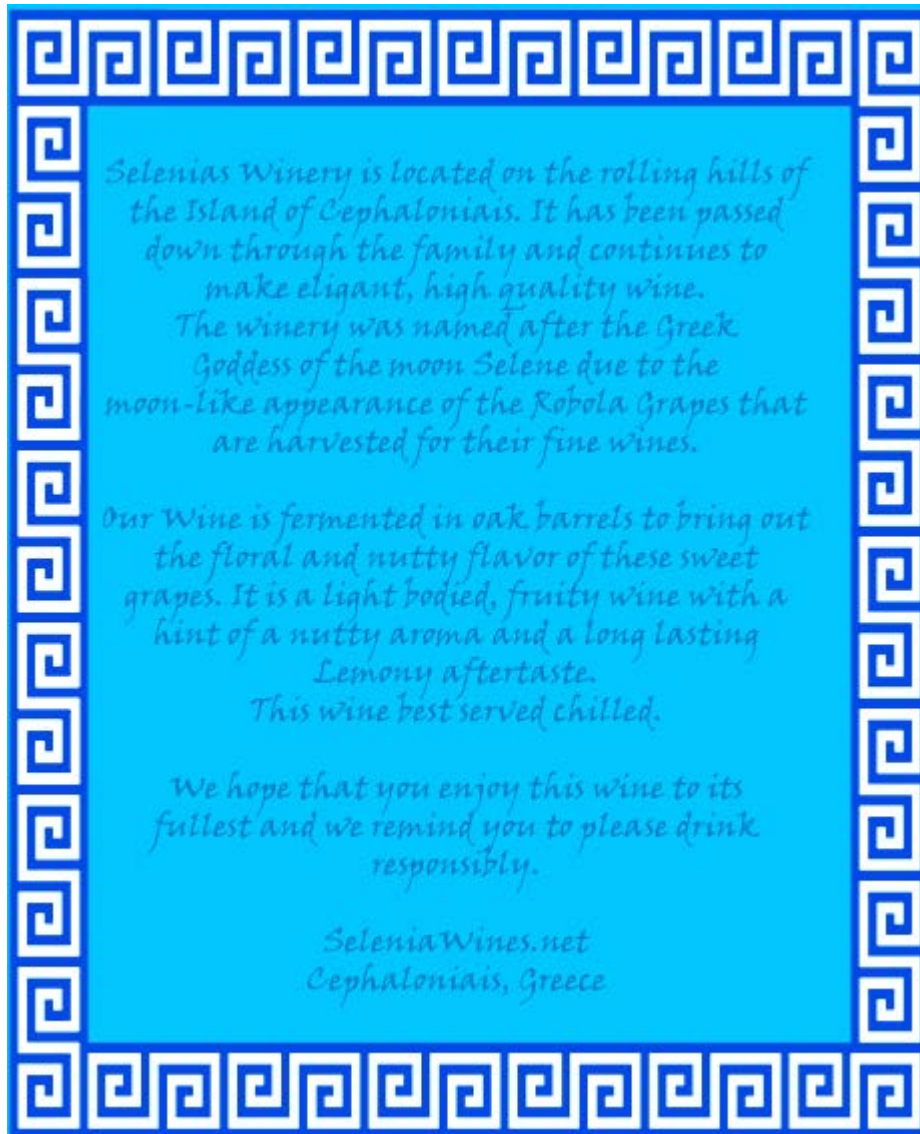

Rationale:
