- Magic(k): sleight of hand, some kind of force in natural world that can be manipulated
- Occult: Hidden Occult knowledge: knowledge hidden accident/purpose for those
- Witch - the knowledge of being a witch (craft) Anthropology → Shamanic

5 unrelated terms

- Historical
- Religion (ist) → Wiccan, Pagan
- Feminist/Goddess Worship: I'm not dealing with always males
- Satan (ism): Modern practices post 1960s

like or as culturally similar

- Culture: Not biologically. We are taught, anthropologist → taboos → very negative/shocking things
- Ritual: Not all rituals are religious. Discussing religious
- Metaphor: Culturally based without like or as. Christianity: literal meaning

Occult: who don't know how to use it. COR MK → for orthodox Jews

Witch: 5 things that are not related to witchcraft

↳ Anthro: anything unfamiliar called witchcraft (structure and belief was unfamiliar to "normal" religion then assumed witchcraft)

Shaman → lead worships

↳ Not english language

Witch: Wartlocks (men) Witch (woman)
