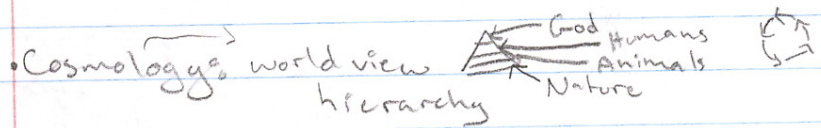
Metaphors will continue to evolve.

↳ multi-layered
 • Mythology: sacred, origin stories, narratives (sung, written, oral) Jan 26
 emic → ↳ Logos: clear, precise, unequivocal meanings
 etic → ↳ Mythos: metaphor words, many meanings at the same time, multi-layer, oral/written text, multi-volume

↳ about how a country, culture, religion comes together

- Emic: Point of view → rituals, from the participants point of view (mi → me)
- Etic: The point of view from outside looking in. (it)



• Liminal(ity): The act of being Liminal, liminal things are un-categorical things. Blurr categories, between state of beings, classification
 ↳ pigeon hole, deft classification.

Race is a social construction

→ APARTHEID

- ↳ white, colored and black → indigenous south africans
- ↳ caucasian ↳ mostly asian/southasian

• Transcendent: Members of a religion → where the divine is primarily located. Outside of the world.

• Immanent: In the world. The divine is primarily located

• Witch: ♀, old, Satan (Devil), evil, warlock ♂ ("Wærloga" → oth breaker), applied to these people (to cast a glamour is to not show someone the real selves)

• Magician/wizard: ♂, old, study, chose → had to know how to curse (how to recognise to undo)
 ↳ kings and wise men, good

• Sorcerer/ess: Both ♀ ♂, young/old, neutral, knowledge from family but only had ↳ fate certain info depending on which family they came from
 faux amie → sound almost the same but mean differently, future-tellers did not make deals, following set recipes, holy water (homeopathic)
