- Komagata Maru
 - Boat that sailed into Vancouver harbour filled with Punjabi immigrants in 1914
 - They were all British subjects (Indian)
 - Anchored 1 km from shore
 - Canadian immigration did not allow them to land
 - Press banned
- Malcolm Reid, immigration officer
 - Westcoast gatekeeper
- Politicians wanted a white Canada policy
 - Canada was still not responsible for its foreign policy
 - Still under British power
- First ship bearing migrants to be turned away from Canadian shores
